2. **Other Business**

- Mr. Weimer stated that with the upcoming Storm DPW would be going out at 4am and would be on duty until at least 7 pm. It was stated that there was already a State Of emergency declared by the Governor and that as of midnight there would be travel restrictions in place and that at 8 am all commercial vehicles would be banned from 380 and 84.
- Ms. Kelly stated that she had gone out with Meredith during the day and had bought various food items and taken it to the DPW garage so that there would be food there for the crew to eat when they could.
- Mr. Weimer said that there needs to be more communication by the county in events like Storm Riley.
- Mr. Weimer stated that one of the DPW trucks is in for repairs more than it is on the road and hopefully they will get to the cause of all the issues. It appears to be only with that particular year. Mr. Lamantia asked if others who have that year truck are also having the same issue and it was not known.
- Due to the upcoming Storm (Skylar) and with the State of Emergency in place and other office's being closed in the complex it was decided to close the Office on March 7, 2018
- Ms. Ruiz-Smith asked what the LST contributions are from the depot and it will be researched.
- Ms. Ruiz-Smith stated that she had a meeting With Kyle Knecht, Russ Kresge, and Cory Seese for 2 hours going over the Tower issues. It was noted that the basement leaking is different from the Tower leaking.

- It was noted by Ms. Ruiz-Smith that the District Judge is very pleased with the work that has been done so far.
- Mr. Weimer said that recognition should be given to the following for all the hard work in Storm Riley
 1. DPW
 2. Coolbaugh Township Fire Dept.
 3. A Pocono Country Place Security Officer that found a house on fire and saved the occupants from the fire
 4. Gouldsboro Fire Company (Station 55) who assisted during the storm
 5. PMREMS
