Public hearing was called to order by Board Chairman Weimer at 6:30pm on the following:

**Public Hearing: Comments on Ordinance #136-2019: An Ordinance to Adopt and Enact an Ordinance Codification for the Township of Coolbaugh, County of Monroe, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to provide for the repeal of certain legislation not included therein; to save from repeal certain other legislation not included therein; and to provide penalties for tampering with the code**

Solicitor Armstrong reviewed the proposed ordinance stating that this ordinance would be for the purpose of updating the Township Code of Ordinance and presenting them in an orderly manner which repeals certain ordinances that are no longer valid, makes grammatical clarifications to language and addresses substantive changes as set forth in Schedule A that is attached to the Ordinance.

Solicitor Armstrong stated that the proposed ordinance was advertised according to the MPC and second class township code and reviewed by the Monroe County Planning Commission and Coolbaugh Township Planning Commission which both returned favorable recommendations.
