



Coolbaugh Township is currently resuming the recruitment process of new membership for Military Vets and Active Military Service Men and Women who would like to partake in the Coolbaugh Township Veterans Committee.

Following is a description of the criteria:

The committee is open to veterans 'at large' so it is not limited to Coolbaugh residents. Membership is open to Monroe County Military Vets in general but trying to recruit membership of those who served post 9/11 in the Gulf War (operational names included Operation Desert Shield, Operation Desert Storm, and Operation Desert Sabre).

War in Iraq

Operation New Dawn (OND; September 2010 - December 2011)

Operation Iraqi Freedom (OIF; 2003 - 2011)

War in Afghanistan

Operation Enduring Freedom (OEF; 2001 - current).

There is no other municipality in Monroe County that has such a committee, specifically one that encourages membership by the younger generation of military personnel who served after the 9/11 attacks.
